

Viewing ebooks in the ABMA Education e-library




You now have the following options:




To view ebooks online, simply click the 'PDF Full Text' button.

To jump to a specific chapter, click the appropriate title.






In this example, Section C was selected and this chapter is now displayed.

Click the next buttons at the bottom of the page.






You can also search by specific terms by clicking the **'SEARCH WITHIN'** button.




Saving and downloading ebooks from the ABMA Education e-library

Saving or downloading ebooks



You MUST create a personal folder if you want to SAVE or DOWNLOAD an ebook.

Click the 'SIGN IN' button.



Setting up your personal folder




This will take you to a login screen.




If you have a Google account, you can 'Sign up with Google' by clicking the blue bar.

You will then be asked to enter your Google username and password.

You will be taken to a terms and conditions page and asked to confirm that you agree with the Terms and Conditions, by ticking a confirmation box.

Then click the CONTINUE button.




You will also need to have installed on your PC, laptop or digital device ADOBE DIGITAL EDITIONS.

If you DO have Adobe Digital Editions then tick the box to confirm this.


Then click FULL DOWNLOAD.

Publisher Rules




You can see here the publisher's rules for use of the ebook.

NOTE, that if you want to print or email the ebook, this is restricted to 20 pages at a time.







Publisher Rules
